Local youngster is part of winning trampoline quartet

A TRAMPOLINE quartet of local youngsters has scooped 1st place in the team event at the West Midlands Trampolining February Regional Assessment and Grading Championships, which were held at Sheffield's

Community Academy in Walsall on Saturday 2nd February.

Eight year old Tia Inskip Clarkson of Cheadle, nine year olds Freya Martin of Trentham, Tyler Biddulph of Knypersley, and Charlotte Perry, who all represented

Stoke Elite Trampoline squad were scored individually and as a team in the under 11G category as they performed a full twist straddle routine. The routine consists of a full twist straddle into a seat drop into a half twisted seat drop into a half twist

to feet into a pike jump into a half twist to feet into a tuck jump and finally into a front somersault tucked.

The quartets collated team score of 133 points beat their closest rivals, G-Force Trampoline squad of Birmingham, into second place by a whopping 12.2 points with their score. And considering the four youngsters were giving away up to two years in age and experience to many of the other ten competitors in the category they got themselves right up there in the individual standings as well with Freya getting a podium 3rd place, Tia taking 4th, Tyler in 6th and Charlotte in 7th.
